There is **NO COST** to you.



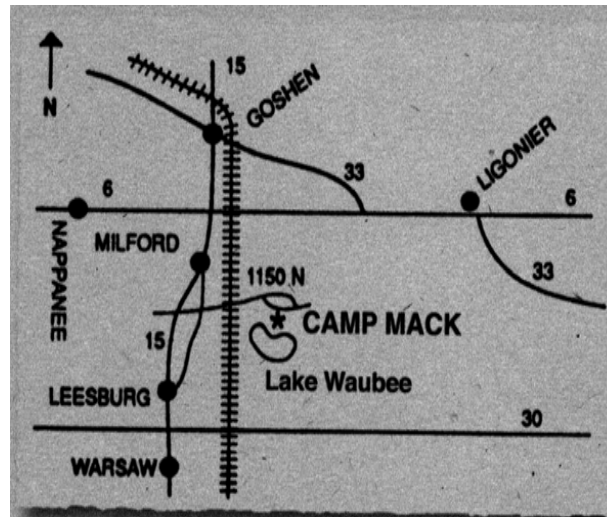
DIRECTIONS AND MAP

From State Road 15:

- South of Milford, IN, turn east off State Road 15 onto Country Road 1150 N.
- Continue east .5 mile past the first stop sign over the railroad tracks.
- Turn right on to Camp Mack Road at the sign.
- Wind around the lake for almost a mile.
- Turn right into the arched entrance of Camp Alexander Mack.

From Northwest Indiana:

Travel east on US 30 to SR 15 North. Follow directions from SR 15 above.

- Camp activities will be the same as all other summer camps (daytime and evening activities to include but not limited to music, arts and crafts, water activities, and Christian Education.)
